

## **Ethnography**

Ethnography is a qualitative orientation to research that emphasizes the detailed observation of people in naturally occurring settings.

You will have to go to a place you have **never** been (an experience you have never had) and observe how people interact in that place. In order to write up an appropriate ethnography, the following guiding questions can be of help.

1. What group do you want to study?
2. What is your motivation?
3. Are there specific things/questions that you would like to learn about?
4. What were the main issues or themes that struck you in this setting?
5. Were there specific issues that you picked up from your observations that you might want to explore further if you are in this setting again?

### **And more generally:**

1. How does your paper teach others about the culture?
2. Remove yourself from the narrative as much as possible so that you showcase the culture/cultural group
