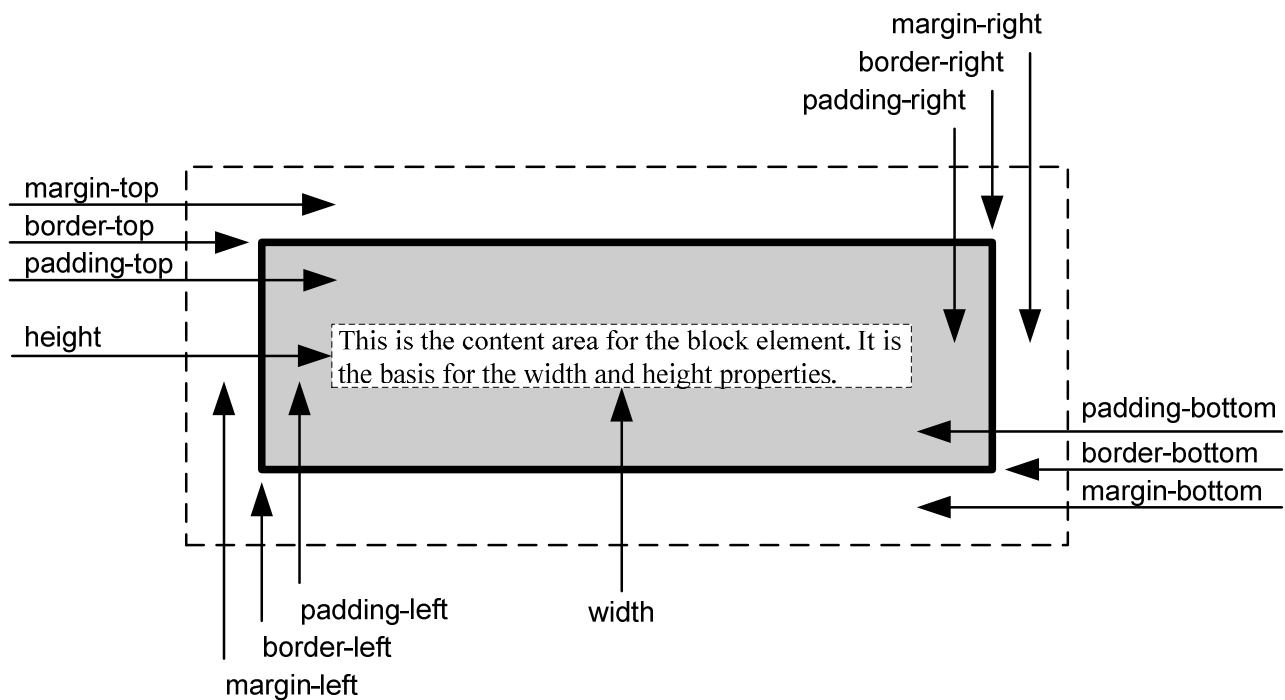


Summary of CSS Box Model



Box-sizing: Difference between content-box and border-box.

- `p {margin: 10px;}`
 - top, right, bottom & left margins are 10px
- `p {margin: 10px 5px;}`
 - top & bottom margins are 10px and left & right margins are 5px
- `p {margin: 10px 15px 20px;}`
 - top margin is 10px, left & right margins are 15px and bottom margin is 20px
- `p {margin: 10px 0 15px 2px;}`
 - margins: **t**op is 10px, **r**ight is 0px, **b**ottom is 15px & **l**eft is 2px (Mnemonic: "**TRouBLE**")
- `p {margin-top: 15px;}`
 - also margin-left, margin-right, margin-bottom

To align text we use `text-align: center;`

However, sometimes it is not the text we want to center but the box as a whole. To do this, we want the left and right margins to be equal. Set them to `auto`. You also need to provide a width or it will take up the whole space.

```
.center {
  margin-left: auto;
  margin-right: auto;
  width: 70%
}
```

You can do the same thing for centering an image. Make it a block first.

```
display: block;
margin-left: auto;
margin-right: auto
```
