

PHP Summary

- Programming code can be embedded directly within an HTML file.
- Instead of having an **.html** extension, a PHP file will usually have the extension **.php**.
- PHP programming code must be contained within an opening **<?php** tag and a matching closing **?>** tag to differentiate it from the HTML

Example:

```
<?php
$user = "Randy";
?>
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
<body>
<h1>Welcome <?php echo $user; ?></h1>
<p>
The server time is
<?php
echo "<strong>";
echo date("H:i:s");
echo "</strong>";
?>
</p>
</body>
</html>
```
